If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that the diapering changing table in the toddler classroom was not smooth. The pad was observed to have designs. The changing table being used did not have a guard or rail present to prevent children from falling. The center was utilizing a red shelf for a changing table.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove the pad and purchase a compliant pad. The center will purchase a changing table and replace the red shelf that is being used.
