- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. # **Activities and Equipment**

#### 591-1-1-.12 Equipment & Toys(CR)

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-1.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on observation that the black shelf at the entry of classroom B was not secured, and could easily be tipped over.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will attach the self with anchoring hooks and secure it to the wall. Consultant printed out the tipping hazards document from the website and reviewed it with the owner on this date.

Consultant discussed keeping items that pose a hazard inaccessible to children such as the vacuum and brooms, store them on the other side of the barriers to keep out of reach of children.

#### 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

#### **Technical Assistance**

591-1-1-.26(4) - Consultant discussed with the Owner, prior to having families enter through the side, that the air conditioner unit would require a four (4) foot barrier around it to keep it inaccessible to the children.

#### **Technical Assistance**

591-1-1-.26(8) - Consultant discussed with the Director the requirements prior to installing swings to ensure the fall zones and resilient surfacing is met. The fall zone would need to extend twelve (12)feet in front of and behind the swings and six (6) feet out each side. Further there may only be two swings per bay.

Correction Deadline: 11/22/2019

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there was an old tree growing through the fence on the left side. Further consultant observed the ground to not be flesh with the walkway posing a tripping hazard.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add construction fencing to enclose the area where the tree is growing through and add dirt around the walkway to ensure it is flesh with the ground.

# **Health and Hygiene**

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required amount of window space provided by operable windows when open. It was determined based on observation that in classroom B there was no ventilation being used during diaper changes.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will install a screen mesh around the door and open it during diapering times to ensure that fresh air is circulating during diapering times.

It was determined based on observation that an infant was present and no crib was available. The owner had a pack 'n' play for the infant to sleep in.

The Center will purchase a crib for the infant to sleep in.
