It was determined based on review of records that a staff member was shadowing in Room B 2L but did not submit both a Records Check Application to the Department or Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site prior to being present at the Center. The consultant left and read the consultant script, a one-day letter, fingerprinting steps, and the A to Z video affidavit on this date.

It was determined based on a review of records that a staff member was shadowing in Room B 2L who did not have a valid current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center. The Consultant left the Consultant script, a one-day letter, fingerprinting steps, and the A to Z video affidavit on this date.
