Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined determined based on observation the fence was observed to be in need of repair:

PG B/R- Multiple areas along the left and center of the fence were observed to need to be tightened and secured to prevent entrapment hazards. Further, on the right side of the playground, the fence was observed to have extra material causing a potential hazard.

### **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
