On this date, the Consultant discussed maintaining license capacity for each classroom and the building with the Director. The Center's overall license capacity is limited to twelve (12) children.

Further, Consultant stated to Center Director and Owner, that prior to providing Transportation and/or Field Trips, the Center is required to contact the assigned Bright from the Start: Regional Consultant, to discuss and review all Transportation and Field Trip requirements.
