If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Activities and Equipment

591-1-1-.12 Equipment & Toys(CR)

Finding

591-1-1-.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on consultant's observation, that hazards existed in classroom A. There were electrical cords hanging from the cafeteria doors and two (2) computer screens were not secured that could be tipped over.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add bungee cords to secure computer screens to the base and attach the cords with a hook so they are not accessible to children.
