#### Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there were three (3) protruding bolts more than two (2) thread on the far right corner pole on playground C.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will turn the bolts around so that they are facing outside of the playground.

# **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based consultant's observation that hazards existed on playgrounds A, B, and C. On playground A, there were exposed tree roots along the left side fence and chipped paint on the handle bar of the blue whale. On playground B, there were exposed tree roots along the left side fence. On playground C, there were exposed tree roots on the far right side and ants along the plastic barrier on the far right side.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will spray the tree roots, sand and repaint the handle bar on the blue whale, and treat for ants.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.15(1) requires that meals and snacks are served, with serving sizes dependent upon the age of the child, that meet nutritional guidelines as established by the United States Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program. Meals and snacks shall be varied daily, and additional servings of nutritious food shall be offered to children over and above the required daily minimum, if not contraindicated by special diets. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there was expired yogurt in the refrigerator. Consultant observed twelve (12) individual Trix yogurt dated May 15, 2018.

It was determined based on consultant's observation that seven (7) of sixteen (16) cribs in classroom D were non complaint as their CPSC codes were 16CFR 1509 and not 16CFR1220.
