It was determined based on investigative findings that the allegation regarding center staff failing to ensure that anyone without a purpose, other than for child care was not on the premises when it was stated that staff members allowed a consignment shop, which was open to the public, to sell their items in the gymnasium of the center. It was reported that the sale was going on during the preschool hours of operation on Friday, February 28, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., while children were present was substantiated.

Advisement of Potential for Repeated Rule Violations during Pending Investigations

The department shall conduct a thorough investigation to determine if in fact the alleged rule violation(s) should or should not be substantiated. Further, from time to time the department discovers additional rule violations during the course of an investigation. If there are new rule violation(s), your consultant shall inform you of the violation(s) as soon as possible. However, as stated above, any violations of identical rule(s) will require the department to treat any and all additional rule violations identified in the investigation as repeated rule violations.

All rule violations found in relation to a complaint or incident investigation will be associated with the date the investigation was closed.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
