An Administrative Review was completed on August 26, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 3, 2020 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issues on August 15, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.
