Comments

On March 22, 2022, the consultant followed up to previous visit and conducted an on-site Monitoring Visit. Consultant requested the provider submit required documents for the Administrative Review process.

An Administrative Review was conducted on March 29, 2022. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. The Consultant completed the exit conference virtually and a copy of the monitoring visit report was electronically emailed to the Program on March 29, 2022.

Consultant requested to review all Criminal Record checks for all employees hired after last visit. Director provided three files for employees hired since last visit.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

The Consultant observed two small blue chairs with small tears in the seat in Room B and Room C. The Director and the Consultant discussed that new classroom furniture had been purchased and that the two small blue chairs would be removed on this date.

591-1-1-.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on the Consultant's observation that the left side cubby in Room B was not secured as required.

- * the back of Playground B had a white plastic pipe with two exposed nails propped up against the fence.
- * the center of Playground B closest to the yellow slide had a plastic green Tike sand toy that had a small tear.
- * the right back side of Playground C had a tree stump that was exposed.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Consultant observed center staff remove the white plastic pipe with exposed nails and the plastic green Tike sand toy from Playground B on this date.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
