- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(4) requires that children under three years old be housed in separate physical areas from older children and cannot be mixed with older children except at specified times and circumstances. It was determined based on statements that children under three-years-old were combined in classroom A with three and four-year-old children longer than the first hour of operation. All of the children were in this classroom from 7:00 a.m to 8:30 a.m., until the completion of breakfast.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.
