The Center will ensure the CRC rules are maintained. The A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records must be viewed and signed by Friday, September 4, 2020.

It was determined based on a review of records that there were 16 employees that did not have a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child was present for care as required.

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date and is due no later than September 4, 2020. The center will ensure the CRC rules are maintained.
