Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that there was a gap measuring four (4) inches between the wood rails when they should be less than three and one half (3-1/2) inches, posing an entrapment hazard.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will enclose the gap with boards along the wood rails so that they are not posing an entrapment hazard.

Health and Hygiene

591-1-1-.10 Diapering Areas & Practices(CR)

Finding

591-1-1.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required amount of window space provided by operable windows when open. It was determined based on measurement of the diapering classrooms that classrooms B, C, D, N, O, P, Q, and R had insufficient ventilation for diapering. Each classroom required 15 square feet of ventilation when only nine (9) square feet was available.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will submit variance for and purchase air purifiers to meet the square footage capacity of each classroom. Classrooms E and F are fully potty trained older 2's and ventilation is not needed for these two classrooms.
