- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on consultant measurements that the fence measured three feet seven inches when four feet is required. The consultant also observed protruding bolts around the gates on the playground measuring between four and six threads.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Director stated she will have repairs done to the fence to ensure it meets the four foot requirement. The Director stated she would cut back the bolts.
