An onsite Licensing Study was completed on 02-24-2022. The center director stated no medication has been administered since the consultant's last visit. No routine transportation or field trips are provided. The center director stated there is a total of 12 staff with one of the twelve being a new hire. The consultant request documents to be uploaded in Koala by close of business on 03-03-2022. The documents were submitted early and the consultant completed the annual review on 03-02-2022. The consultant discussed the findings with the center director and emailed a copy to the director for a date and signature and to be returned to the consultant.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





### **Important New Deadlines:**

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.
