- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on observation that the red shelf by the front door entrance and the round table in the housekeeping area were unstable and easily tipped over in entrance classroom of the Main building.

The director removed the unstable table from the classroom and stated that the res shelf will be bolted to the ground. The Center will ensure that the two shelves are anchored and secured. The center will repair or replace changing table in classroom C.

It was determined based on review of records that two employees hired on May 19, 2009 and August 1, 2018, did not have documentation of Health and Safety Orientation.

The director stated that Health and Safety Training will be conducted on Saturday, August 10, 2019 by Melissa Cox. The Center will develop and implement a plan to schedule and track this training for all employees based on their hire dates.
