- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

It was determined based on Consultant observation the Cafeteria area lacked a variety of toys and play materials in the area of art, dramatic play, science, manipulatives, musical instruments and books. Room 112 lacked musical instruments.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center director will ensure there is a variety of age-appropriate toys and play materials in the required centers in each room for each age group that are stored on low, open shelves accessible to children.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on Consultant observation screw protrusions were observed on the fence gate and corner poles accessible to the children in care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use. The program is located on school property. A variance was submitted on this date.

591-1-1-17(7) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids and after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on Consultant observation the bathroom sinks and sinks in the classroom lacked warm running water.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff on required handwashing for children and Staff will ensure children's hands are washed when required. The Director will monitor for compliance. The After School program is located on Public School property. A variance was submitted on this date.

It was determined based on Consultant observation the program plan to serve (4) year old, after school age definition starts at (5) year old.
