- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation 11 protruding screws were observed on the gates of the playground fence measuring over the two threads. Consultant also observed a gap in the back of the four (4) feet lattice fencing around the three (3) air conditioning units in route to the playground area measuring five inches to seven inches which poses an entrapment hazard to the children in care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will turn the 11 screws on the gates facing outwards and cut down the screws to two threads and sand for the screws that are accessible to the children in care. The center will also add extra wood on the fencing to close the gaps on the air conditioning units.
