- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is <u>valid for thirty(30) days</u>. Please be mindful to keep items that pose a hazard inaccessible to children. Discussed the following: removing teacher desks in rooms or ensuring that hazardous items such as hand sanitizer and teacher supplies are kept out of reach of children or in locked cabinets/drawers. Also discussed the need to secure any refrigerators located in rooms.

591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

Technical Assistance

Discussed maintaining equipment free of dirt and buildup, fence free of chipping paint, low hanging limbs cut so they are not at eye level, maintain cement pads level with ground, and to remove any exposed sprinkler heads.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that there were bolts protruding on the fence between Playground B and C at the corners and around the gate.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

Health and Hygiene

591-1-1-.10 Diapering Areas & Practices(CR)

Comment

The building has an indoor air quality ventilation system that meets the rules/regulations for ventilation for diapering areas and restrooms.

Finding

591-1-1-.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that Room D that will house 18-24 month old children did not have a diaper changing surface as required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. Center Staff will be trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.

Proper hand washing of children and staff was discussed with the director. Hands shall be washed with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids (sneezing, wiping nose, etc.), and after contamination by any other means.
