If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.12(2)(d) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined toy shelves in the infant room, the toddler room and the three year old classroom were not anchored as required. The shelves were observed to be approximately one foot wide and could be easily tipped over by climbing or pulling on them. All shelves that are light weight and narrow should be anchored safely to prevent hazards to the children.

591-1-112(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on consultant's observation that all low shelves in the three classrooms in Building 1 which houses children ages one year to three years of age were not secured to prevent injury from tipping, falling or being pulled over. At least two shelving units in each classroom were observed to need securing.
