- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

- Broom and dust pan were accessible near right bathroom
- -Plastic storage bags were in children's cubby
- -Cords accessible in blue, green, and yellow balance scale (1st Left):
- Hand sanitizer, gloves, and one pack of baby wipes in the classrooms food preparation area (on top of cubby storage)

(3rd Left):

- -Plastic storage bags were in children's cubby
- -Two packs of baby wipes (Johnson & Johnson Hand and Face wipes and Parent's Choice Sensitive Care wipes) were in the changing table

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the perimeter of the playground had an over growth of thorny vines which could pose a potential hazard to the children.
