If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.06(4) requires a Center first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that remodel or add to existing plumbing facilities, to have the bathroom area fully enclosed and ventilated to the outside of the building with either an open screened window or functioning exhaust fan and duct system and requires Centers without fully enclosed bathrooms to ensure there is adequate ventilation to control odors and adequate sanitation measures to prevent the spread of contagious diseases. It was determined based on observation that the vent located in classroom A and classroom D bathrooms were not in working order.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that the bathroom vents are in working order in all bathrooms. The center director notified the maintenance person on site to schedule the repairs.

Please continue to fluff and redistribute mulch as needed underneath fall zone areas. Please ensure that all playgrounds are free of hazards. There was an active ant bed on the left playground; however the director treated the ant bed on this date. There was also wasp nests on the back playground underneath the gazebo; however, children were not playing on this playground. The director sprayed the wasp nests and removed them on site.

Correction of citation observed on this date. The divider fence on the playground was not required to have a four feet barrier as it was located in the middle of the playground and not surrounding the playground which leads to the parking lot. The center has placed black siding on both sides of the fence.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that on the left playground, there were bolts missing on the tan and green climbing structure near the slide on the bottom left and top right corners of the structure.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that on the left playground, there was splintering wood surrounding a small enclosure next to the swimming pool area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
