Comments

This Licensing Study is the first regulatory visit for Mt. Zion Learning Center this 2019 - 2020 fiscal year. The center director stated medication is administered, field trips and routine transportation is not provided.

The center director stated a total of four new pieces of playground equipment has been installed amongst the two playgrounds which require resilient surface. Additionally, that the playgrounds have not been in use and will remain closed until the resilient surface has been installed. The children have been utilizing the multipurpose playroom and large gym for playtime activities.

Two new employees have been hired since the consultants last visit. The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file.

Additionally, the child was given the 11 AM dose, was signed out at 3:40 PM and had not been given the 3:00 PM dose.
