Finding

591-1-1-.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on observation that the purple shelf in the three-year-old class room was of a size and height that presented a tipping hazard and was not secured to the wall and presented a hazard to children in care.

The Center will ensure that the identified equipment or furniture and any other such existing or future items are secured adequately and will have a system for checking these for stability.

591-1-1-.25(11) - The consultant observed the vinyl flooring in the three-year-old classroom to have two areas where the vinyl was worn down and missing. Beneath the vinyl was concrete flooring. In the short term the director will monitor the areas to ensure they do not pose a tripping hazard to children in care. In the long term the director will look at repairing, removing, or replacing the vinyl floor in the effected area.

Finding

591-1-1.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that all four corners of the changing table were cracked and had sharp edges that posed a hazard to children in care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. Center Staff will be trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.
