- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. It was determined based on measurements taken at four areas of fall zones at all four combination wooden climbers with slides that the fall zones had 2 to 3 inches, in depth, of wood mulch. Due to the height of the equipment these pieces of equipment require a six inch depth of resilient surfacing in the fall zone areas. POI (Plan of Improvement) The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency. Finding

591-1-1-.36(3)(a-b) requires any Center that provides any type of transportation to obtain two (2) hours of state-approved or state-accepted transportation training, biannually, for the Director and for each person responsible for or who participates in the transportation of children. The training shall include, but is not limited to, a review of the transportation rules, a review of approved transportation forms and procedures, and instruction on the usage and completion of the forms and procedures. This training may be counted as part of the annual training requirements for Staff. It was determined, based on review of transportation documentation to include required transportation training that two out of three drivers for the center had expired transportation training. Transportation training is required to be completed at least every two years.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that the Director, Center Staff, and any person responsible for the transportation of children has completed the required transportation training. The Program Director will put a system in place to track when transportation training is due.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(4)(a) requires an annual safety check for each vehicle. The annual safety check, completed by a trained individual, should include a check of the: tires, headlights, horn, tail lights, turn signals, brake lights, brakes, suspension, exhaust system, steering, windows, windshields and windshield wipers. A copy of the annual safety check will be kept in the Center or on the vehicle and should include evidence of any repairs and/or replacements that were identified as needed on the inspection report. It was determined based on consultant's review of required transportation documentation that the two buses used for routine transportation with tags ending in 2037 and 2038 did not have an annual safety check. The safety checks for both vehicles were dated 3/10/18 and are more than a year old.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will obtain the annual vehicle inspection.

It was determined based on the consultant's review of all 14 staff records that 7 staff did not complete 10 hours of annual training in 2018.

The Center will plan and schedule the required 10 hours of annual training each year and follow up to ensure the training is completed. the Program director will put a system in place to track ongoing annual training hours for staff members.
