Finding

- Exposed tree roots were present throughout playgrounds B- Left Back and D -Right Front, causing a potential tripping hazard.

- Exposed sharp edges of concrete were present throughout playground D-Right Front and along the sidewalk path on playground B- Left Back, causing a potential tripping hazard.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

591-1-1-17(7) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids and after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on observation that one child in room J-3R did not wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water after wiping their nose. Further, the child was observed to return to their center to play without being reminded by staff to wash their hands.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff on required handwashing for children and Staff will ensure children's hands are washed when required. The Director will monitor for compliance.

Finding

91-1-1-.33(5) requires that every calendar year after the first year of employment, all supervisory and caregiver Personnel, except independent contractors, Students-in-Training and volunteers shall attend ten (10) clock hours of diverse training which is task-focused in on-going health, safety and early childhood or child development related topics and which is offered by an accredited college, university or vocational program or other Department-approved source. The annual ten (10) clock hours of training shall be chosen from the following fields: child development, including discipline, guidance, nutrition, injury control and safety; health, including sanitation, disease control, cleanliness, detection and disposition of illness; child abuse and neglect, including identification and reporting, and meeting the needs of abused and/or neglected children; and business related topics, including parental communication, recordkeeping, etc.; provided however that such business related training shall be limited to no more than two (2) of the required ten (10) clock hours of training. Records of completion of such training shall be maintained, as required by these rules. It was determined based on review of records that the following staff members did not possess the ten clock hours of training after their first year of employment:

- Staff member #16 with a documented date of hire of September, 1 2015
- Staff member # 19 with a documented date of hire of May 7, 2008
- Staff member # 11 with a documented date of hire of June 22, 2018
- Staff member # 21 with a documented date of hire of June 13, 2018
- Staff member # 14 with a documented date of hire of August 3, 2002
- Staff member # 4 with a documented date of hire of January 3, 2018

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will plan and schedule the required 10 hours of annual training each year and follow up to ensure the training is completed.
