## Comments

An Administrative Review was conducted on Januarry 6, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training and background checks were all reviewed. A vitual inspection was conducted on Januarty 7, 2020 with the Provider. An in-person visit was not conducted dur to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued August 15, 2020 was discussed.

Consultant disucssed new rules that went into effect October 1, 2020. Resources were emailed to provider after the virtual visit.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

In summary,

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
