Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards were present:

* A water hose that was accessible to children was observed on the outdoor play area.

* Plastic bags filled with empty milk jugs and plastic bottles were observed accessible to children on the outdoor play area.

Red bricks that were accessible to children were observed on the outdoor play area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.

Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based on observation that the provider's back fencing was observed to measure three feet nine inches when a fencing height of four-feet was required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence.
