It was further determined that the provider did not conduct tornado and other emergency drills every six months in 2016.

It was determined based on a review of records that the cat's vaccinations were not current when they expired in November 2017. In addition, when consultant arrived to the family child care learning home the cat was inside the home, and accessible to children in care.
