If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

The Home will have in place procedures for evacuation, relocation, shelter-in-place, lock-down, communication and reunification with families, continuity of operations, accommodation of infants and toddlers, children with disabilities, and children with chronic medical conditions. No Home personnel shall impede in any way the delivery of emergency care or services to a child by licensed or certified emergency health care professionals. It was determined based on review of records that the Home did not have a written plan for handling emergencies on file.

It was determined based on review of the records that the helper present on this date did not have evidence of completing helper orientation.

The Home will ensure that either the Provider or at least one Adult who has received orientation in all required areas supervises the children at all times. The Home will develop or update a plan to obtain additional Adult help in case of an emergency.
