Previously Cited: 290-2-3-.08(2)(c) 18 requires notification of the absence of a liability insurance policy sufficient to protect its clients. Each parent or guardian must acknowledge receipt of such notice, and a copy of the acknowledgement shall be kept in the child's file. It was determined based on a review of records, that none of the enrolled children had evidence of signed No Liability Signature Forms.
