#### **Finding**

290-2-3-.07(14) requires that each adult responsible for the supervision of the children, if not the Provider, shall receive orientation regarding these rules; the Provider's policies regarding discipline, injuries and illnesses, and release of Children; the Provider's written plan for handling emergencies; and appropriate information about any Child's specific health needs. It was determined based upon consultant's observation, that the helper present at the home did not have proof of an orientation on this date.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will ensure that each adult responsible for the supervision of the children, shall receive orientation regarding these rules, the Provider's required policies, plans for handling emergencies and appropriate information about any Child's specific health needs.

#### **Finding**

290-2-3-.07(4) requires the Provider, Employees and Provisional Employees with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment. Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the training within the first 90 days of employment. The training must address the following health and safety topics: prevention and control of infectious diseases; prevention of sudden infant death syndrome and use of safe sleeping practices; administration of medication, consistent with standards for parental consent; prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions; building and physical premises safety, including identification of and protection from hazards that can cause bodily injury such as electrical hazards, bodies of water, and vehicular traffic; prevention of shaken baby syndrome and abusive head trauma; emergency preparedness and response planning for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster, or threatening event such as violence at the facility; handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio contaminants; and precautions in transporting children (if applicable). It was determined based upon consultant's observation, that the helper present at the home did not have proof of completing the health and safety training on this date.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Provider will complete the required training and will ensure any Employees complete the training. The Provider will develop a plan to ensure that any new Employees complete the training as required.
