Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. The system would not allow Consultant to mark the Admin Review Process in "Consultant Review or Completed" at this time but documents were observed. A virtual inspection was conducted on Wednesday, February 3, 2021 with the /Provider, Yolanda Ray. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on May 12, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Consultant provided a First Aid Checklist, Communicable Disease Chart, LiveScan Instructions, Training Info and Rule Changes on this date.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
