The provider stated she contacted Henry Count fire department on January 27, 2020 to follow up from their previous inspection of the fire extinguisher from December 4, 2019. The provider stated the fire department reported a commercial sized extinguisher was needed in the home. The provider will purchase another fire extinguisher by February 21, 2020.
