If individually marked, they must be laundered weekly or more frequently if needed. It was determined based on observation, two children were observed not to have a cover while napping.

The Home Provider will launder covers for sheets or mats as required.

It was determined based on review of children's records that one of six children did not have an enrollment record on file.

Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based on observation, the fence located on the outdoor playground was observed to be damaged from the snow storm in January 2018. Multiple areas were observed to have trees still laying on top of the fence.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Consultant discussed with provider about getting a temporary four-foot high fence or other Departmentapproved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. The Home will install or repair a fence around swimming pools that makes them inaccessible to children.
