If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

290-2-3-.12(5) requires all indoor and outdoor furniture, activity materials, and equipment shall be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint and kept clean. It was determined based on consultant observation that the following items on the playground were in need of repair: -little tikes white storage bin was busted at the bottom with sharp edges

-Step 2 house was obesrved to have the roof smashed in where children cannot adequately stand up, and broken toys inside

-tricycle was obesrved to be missing a pedel and handle

-little tikes push cart was observed to be missing the handles and had busted wheels

-green rocking horse was observed to be missing handles and was busted in the front with sharp edges

-tricycle was obesrved to be missing the seat and pedals

-the yellow buggy was obesrved to have a busted wheel

The Home will repair or replace any identified hazardous or unclean equipment and will monitor all indoor and outdoor equipment to ensure it is free from hazards and kept clean.
