

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation of consultant that petroleum jelly, styling gel, toothpaste and a first aid kit were accessible to children on the bathroom counter. In addition, clorox, lysol, raid bug spray and dish detergent were located in an unlocked kitchen cabinet and accessible to children.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the Home Provider will make these items inaccessible to the children.

The Family Child Care Learning Home will submit an application for a Child Care Learning Center and receive a license to operate from the Department before caring for more than six children, related or unrelated, for pay.
