Such records shall include: identifying information (Child's name, birth date, Parent's name, home and business addresses, telephone numbers); name, address and telephone number of persons, including Child's physician, to contact in emergencies; and name, address, telephone numbers, relationship to Child and to Parent(s) and other identifying information of person(s) to whom the Child may be released. It was determined based on review of files that one of seven enrolled children were missing information pertaining to the father's work and home address and physician.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home Provider will obtain the missing information and maintain the Children's records as required.

It was determined based on review of files that one child present in the home did not have the required form completed on file.

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on consultant observation that a lawn mower was on the right side of the home on the playground accessible the the children.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.
