It was determined based on observation that a portion of the back fence had fallen due to a tree falling on it.

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence or other Department-approved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. The Home will install or repair a fence around swimming pools that makes them inaccessible to children. The provider will remove the tree limbs and repair the fence.
