It was determined, based on an observation that there were baby wipes which stated "keep out of reach of children" located in a child's bookbag on a shelf accessible to children in care. It was further determined, that there were plastic bags located in children's cubbies on this date. It was determined, based on an observation that there were several vines and shrubs growing through the back and right side of the fencing material. It was further determined, that there were two active ant hills/beds on the children's outside play area on this date.
