#### Finding

290-2-3-.08(11) requires that if the Home is not covered by liability insurance sufficient to protect its clients, the Home must notify the Parent of each Child under the care of the program in writing. It was determined based on observation that one of six children enrolled was observed to be without a signed liability form.

The Home Provider will obtain and maintain documentation.

It was determined based on observation that two of six children enrolled were observed to have immunization records that had expired.

It was determined based on observation that two active ant beds were observed near the left side fencing. The consultant further observed overgrown debris to be growing over and threw the outdoor fencing.

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.
