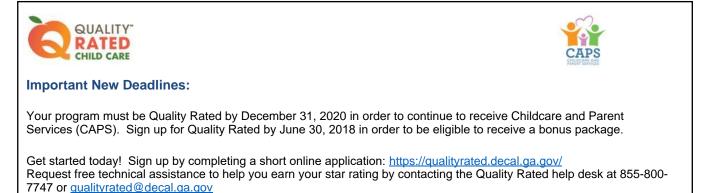

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that there were two active ant beds on the playground area. One ant bed was located next to the sidewalk by the door and the second ant bed was located by the fence on the right hand side of the yard. The provider stated that the larger ant bed by the sidewalk was treated the day before but it was observed to still be active.

The Home will treat ant beds and conduct a daily playground safety check to ensure there are no hazards on the playground.
