It was determined based on the consultant's observation that a medium sized active ant bed was present beside the Little Tykes climbing cube.

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards. The provider will treat the ant bed once the children leave for the day.
