A virtual inspection was conducted on September 13, 2021 with the Provider. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on May 28, 2021, was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

(O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
