Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation, potential outdoor hazards were observed. Several protruding screws/bolts were in the corners and gate of the fence. Bushes and weeds were also observed growing through the back portion of the fence.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards. Protruding bolts will be trimmed to two threads of the nut and filed smooth or capped. The bushes growing through the fence will be trimmed.
