290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based on observation that a 4.5 inch gap was underneath the gate on the right side of the playground and a 3 inch gap was observed in the middle section of the back fence due to a missing board.
