The purpose of the visit was to conduct an initial licensing study this date. The provider was issued permission to operate.

The provider is a tenant of the home, and has a lease to operate the bottom level as a Family Child Care licensed program. The lease will be maintained to cover continued operation of the licensed program.

The entrance to the daycare is located to the left side of the home through the wood gated fence.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is <u>valid for thirty(30) days</u>. #### Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation, the consultant observed two sticker bushes, two tree stumps and exposed rocks that posed a potential hazard on this date.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards. The provider stated, she will discuss with the homeowner plans to remove the bushes, paint the tree stumps and remove the rocks.

The consultant observed the provider to add orange construction netting to one side to identify the area of the yard used by the licensed program. The consultant observed the orange netting to have gaps at each corner and not secured towards the middle on this date. The provider will ensure the orange netting is secured and that no gaps are present to eliminate access to other potential hazards located within the wood fenced yard.
