#### Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based on Consultant observation the barrier and gate at the steps surrounding the deck of the back porch measured at three feet three inches instead of the required four feet in height. Consultant also observed a six inch gap at the bottom of the railing accessible to the children in care.

#### **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence or other Department-approved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. Provider will add a border at the top of the enclosed deck and add a swing door at the entrance to the step that measure at the required four feet. in height.

It was determined based on Consultant observation the diaper changing table lacked a non porous surface.

To ensure the control of disease transmission, the Home Provider will change diapers in the child's crib or a non porous surface. The diapering surface will be cleaned and disinfected between use with a single use disposable towel. A non porous mat will be added to the table that can be cleaned with a disinfectant.
