- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

At least one 2-A:10-B:C fire extinguisher shall be kept in the child care area to be located no more than thirty feet from the kitchen. The extinguisher shall be maintained in working order and shall be inaccessible to the children. It was determined based on observation that the correct size fire extinguisher was not present in the home when a 1-A:10-B:C was present.

The home provider will ensure that an appropriate sized fire extinguisher is available in the child care area as required, and is maintained inaccessible to children.

#### **Finding**

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation that the HVAC unit was accessible on the playground. In addition, the right side of the yard was heavily sloped and uneven due to erosion from recent heavy rain.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will fill in the uneven and sloped area of the yard and ensure that children are kept from the area until the repairs are made. Discussed that the HVAC unit should be enclosed with a sturdy and secure barrier that is at least 4 feet tall. The playground will be monitored daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.
