Permission to operate was granted on October 20, 2020 upon receipt of pictures showing barrier enclosing the hot water heater. The exit conference was conducted on October 20, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. with the Provider being in Compliance with the Executive Order issued August 18, 2020. Permission to Operate was not issued during the virtual visit on October 19, 2020. An Administrative Review was conducted on September 18, 2020, reviewed aprovals, trainings, and background checks. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Provider does not carry liability insurance.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is <u>valid for thirty(30) days</u>. 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) requires that poisons, medicines, cleaning agents and other hazardous materials be in locked areas or inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation, the hot water heater near the restroom lacked a barrier to prevent the children from having access.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the Home Provider will make these items inaccessible to the children by adding a four foot barrier to enclose the hot water heater. Upon completion pictures will be submitted and reviewed by the Consultant. Provider submitted pictures showing enclosure of hot water heater at 9:49 p.m. for Consultant to review. The barrier was reviewed and approved. Regional Consultant will check the barrier at on site visit to ensure it is sturdy.
